Hi Everyone!

Last Sunday, if you were able to join in to one of our services, you would have heard me share from the start of our summer series in the book of Colossians. A point that I kept coming back to was that "Jesus in everything allows us to love in everything."

Since Sunday, that phrase has been playing through my head a lot. As a result, I have been asking myself whether that has been true of me. And as I reflect on this, I

began to wonder how much relationship stress, work stress, family struggles, and overall heaviness of life could be diminished if we lived like "Jesus in everything allows us to love in everything"? That is not to say that we won't have problems (because we will). But just maybe, would our response be different?

I also think of the Church (large C – North American Church at large). As I think of some of the ways in recent weeks that the Church has failed on the public stage, and areas where the testimony of the Church has been heavily damaged, I wonder how things would be different if the church truly lived in a way that showed "Jesus in everything allows us to love in everything?"

What I am trying to get at today is that Jesus is transformational. He changes lives. He changes our lives. And if we live our lives with Him as our focus and with Him as our centre, and we live our lives fully surrendered to His control, we can respond in a way that we never thought possible in the difficult seasons – in love, in His love. How much difference could that make, even today?
