## **Our Re-Opening Plans & Expectations**

As you are aware, things are changing again provincially regarding the current COVID 19 lockdown. As there is a possibility of re-opening our church to weekend services again in the coming couple weeks, we are awaiting further clarification and guidance from our local health unit. Once it becomes clear surrounding what colour level we will be in, and what the reworked guidelines specific to that level will be, we will provide further information.

After we get the go ahead from our local health unit, based on the guidance they will give us, we will plan on re-opening as soon as we are able to safely make that happen from an administrative and logistical standpoint. Expect a delay between the lifting of restrictions and our reopening as we ensure our building and our registration process is in functional and safe order.
