- 4) Click on it. That will take you to our channel where our live stream should pop up.
- 5) Click on the live stream for that day.

When you are on our channel, you can click the 'subscribe' button, which will make you a subscriber to all of our videos. For those who watch us directly through the feed on www.hanovermissionary.com/live, it has been corrected and should stream live this Sunday morning.
